## Sample Thank You Follow-Up Letter

Each time an individual offers to volunteer, the campaign/Volunteer Coordinator should quickly follow-up with a thank you note and a volunteer form if it has not already been filled out. This will reinforce good feelings about the candidate and the campaign, remind them of the specific time and location for their volunteering, and increase the likelihood that the volunteer will show up.
