St Clair claimed she gave birth to the secret child five months ago and has been raising him.

Tech mogul Musk, 53, is yet to respond to the claims directly.

St Clair announced she has a baby in a social media post on Friday which read: "Five months ago, I welcomed a new baby into the world.

She captioned the post "Alea Iacta Est" which is Latin for "the die is cast".

Less than an hour after the claims were first posted on Musk's own X site, the world's richest man shared a cryptic post with followers.

A fan made a detailed post explaining how to be "Elon" which included several "side quests" from buying Twitter to helping [Donald Trump](#) win the 2024 presidential election.

**DOGE in a bid to downsize**

The final line said: "Side-side-side-side quest: make another baby."

Musk - who is often quick to respond to almost anything on social media - replied to the fan with a simple crying laughing emoji.

The SpaceX CEO and St Clair are not believed to have had a relationship together in the past.

They have publicly had several back and forth chats on X across the years.

One unearthed conversation from November 2023 shows St Clair telling her followers she has stopped using birth control to help with her mental health.

Musk sent her a two word reply simply saying "for sure".

The Tesla boss has 12 confirmed children with at least three women.

He shares five children with his first wife Justine Wilson.

The pair had twins Vivian and Griffin in 2004 before having triplets Kai, Saxon and Damian two years later.

They got divorced in 2008 and share custody of the five children.

A decade later, Musk and popular Canadian musician Grimes, whose real name is Claire Elise Boucher, started dating before giving birth to a seventh boy in 2020.

The child hit the headlines as soon as he was born after Musk announced he was called "X Æ A-12".

His name was quickly shortened to X with the cheeky four-year-old recently heading to The White House alongside his dad as they met up with President Donald Trump.

X was seen playing around in the Oval Office, picking his nose and even having a stare off with the president.

Grimes also gave birth to Musk's first girl in 2021 before they had a third child together in 2023.

These were given the names Exa Dark Siderael and boy Techno Mechanicus.



In between their first and second child, court documents later revealed Musk had his eighth and ninth children with Shivon Zilis.

She is the director of operations and special projects at Neuralink.

## Who Is Ashley St. Clair? Author Says She's Had Elon Musk's 13th Child

On Friday, conservative influencer Ashley St. Clair announced that five months ago she had a baby with tech billionaire [Elon Musk](#), head of the [Department of Government Efficiency \(DOGE\)](#). [In a post on X](#), the Musk-owned platform on which she has a million followers, St. Clair said she was making the announcement to preempt the baby's existence being revealed by "tabloid media" acting "regardless of the harm it will cause."

*Newsweek* contacted Ashley St. Clair and Elon Musk, via the [Tesla](#) and [SpaceX](#) press offices, for comment via email on Saturday outside of regular office hours.

## The Context

Musk was already known to having had [12 children via three different women](#), his ex-wife Justine Wilson, singer Grimes and Shivon Zilis, an executive at his company Neuralink. his first child with Wilson died just weeks after its birth in sudden infant death syndrome-related incident.

Over the years, Musk has spoken out repeatedly about declining human birth rates, warning in October 2024 this could lead to ["mass extinction of entire nations"](#) in October 2024.

## What to Know

On Friday, St. Clair posted "Alea lacta Est" on X, Latin which roughly translates as "the die is cast," along with a statement announcing the baby.

In the statement, St. Clair said her baby was born five months ago and that Musk was the father. She added that she had not previously disclosed this to protect the child's privacy and safety.

There is some confusion over St. Clair's age, with British tabloid *The Sun* saying she is 26, while the *New York Post* reports she is 31.

St. Clair wrote for satirical website the Babylon Bee, a conservative-leaning version of The Onion. The Babylon Bee had been banned from [Twitter](#), now X, for awarding then Health and Human Services assistant secretary [Dr. Rachel Levine](#), a transgender woman, its "man of the year" award in 2022. The account was reinstated after Musk purchased the platform.

In July 2021, St. Clair published *Elephants Are Not Birds*, a children's book described as an "unapologetic rebuke of transgender acceptance." In the book, a vulture called Culture tries to persuade an elephant named Kevin that he is also a bird, on the basis that he can sing well. Speaking to the *Daily Mail*, St. Clair said in the end Kevin "realizes he's better the way he was made and he can like to sing and still be an elephant."

St. Clair featured on conservative beer brand Ultra Right's "Real Women of America 2024 Calendar," which was released in December 2023. The calendar featured a number of young women in seductive poses, some in bikinis. St. Clair was pictured in a bubble bath wearing a black bra and pearl necklace, in an apparent reference to a video released by transgender influencer [Dylan Mulvaney](#) for [Bud Light](#).

The calendar sparked a debate among conservatives, which was dubbed Calendargate, with some believing it was too debasing and others defending the project.

In 2023, St. Clair went viral on social media by making a series of X posts on a flight from Phoenix to New York City in which she said the other [passengers were primarily "migrants"](#) who crossed the border and are being shipped to New York."

Following St. Clair's latest announcement, an X post she made in November 2023 resurfaced on the social media platform.

In it St. Clair wrote: "Stopping birth control and Adderall was one of the best things I ever did for my mental health." Musk then responded: "For sure."

What People Are Saying

**St. Clair's statement on Friday read:** "Five months ago, I welcomed a new baby into the world. Elon Musk is the father. I have not previously disclosed this to protect our child's privacy and safety, but in recent days it has become clear that tabloid media intends to do so, regardless of the harm it will cause.

"I intend to allow our child to grow in a normal and safe environment. For that reason, I ask that the media honor our child's privacy, and refrain from invasive reporting."

Responding to St. Clair's X post, **conservative commentator Candice Owens** [said](#): "Children should always be off limits. Journalists are parasites. Hard to imagine going through this with a young one." **Jack Posobiec, editor of right-wing website Human Events**, [posted](#): "God bless you and your family, Ash."

What's Happens Next

Musk has been active on X since St. Clair's announcement, posting about Vice President [JD Vance's](#) Munich speech, Indian Prime Minister [Narendra Modi's](#) U.S. visit and his rocket launches among other subjects. However, he has yet to comment on reports he has a new baby.
